Accessible transcript

Secretary of State for Transport's traffic authorisation of traffic signs for the purpose of informing road users of parking payment options on roads for which City of London Corporation is the traffic authority.

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of her powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other powers enabling her in that behalf for the purpose of informing road users of parking payment options on roads for which City of London Corporation is the traffic authority, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at appropriate sites on the said roads of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign”) consisting of a sign provided for in Schedule 4, Part 4 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (Part 1 of S.I. 2016/362, “the 2016 Regulations”) save that any of the following legends may be added to the authorised sign:
 - a) Pay by app
 - b) Pay by app or phone
 - c) Pay by app or text
2. directs that the authorised sign must include an alternative method of payment from Schedule 4, Part 4, Item 7, Column 5 of the 2016 Regulations when the legend in paragraph 1(a) is shown on the authorised sign; and
3. directs that the variants shown in Schedule 4, Part 4, Item 7, Column 5 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner they apply to the sign shown in Schedule 4, Part 4, Item 7 of those Regulations; and
4. directs that the authorised sign shall only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; and



5. directs that the provisions of Schedule 4, Parts 1 to 6 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 4, Part 4 of those Regulations; and
6. directs that the design of the authorised sign must be in compliance with the requirements in Schedule 4, Part 2 of the 2016 Regulations and any specific guidance and requirements identified in the Traffic Signs Manual Chapter 3 and Chapter 8; and
7. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provisions to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 5, 6, 7, 8 and 11 of the 2016 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the signs shown in Schedule 4, Part 4 of those Regulations.

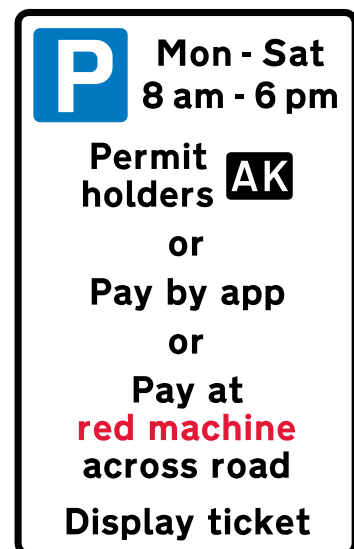
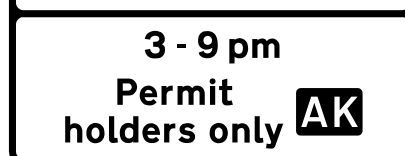
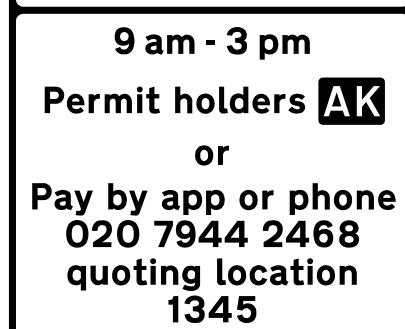
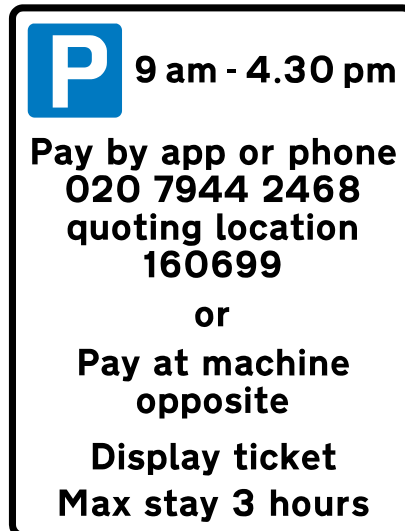
