

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65 AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of indicating to cyclists a route across a signal controlled junction at the Hambrook Junction in South Gloucestershire, hereby:-

- authorises the placing at the site indicated schematically on the attached plan numbered GT50/145/0014-1 of a road marking (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised marking A") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered WBM (R) 294, save that the overall size and shape of the said marking shall be as shown on the said plan and may be reflectorised; and
- 2. authorises the placing at the sites marked schematically on the said plan of a traffic sign consisting of a road marking (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised marking B") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown in diagram 1001.2 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of S.I. 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations"), save that the width and depth of the advance stop lines shall be as shown in the said plan; and
- 3. authorises the erection at or within 2 metres of the sites indicated schematically on the said plan of a light signal (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised light signal") conforming as to size, colour and character with the light signal to diagram 3000.2 in Schedule 8 to the 2002 Regulations save that the authorised light signal shall include at the top signal position a red cycle symbol conforming as to size and character with those shown in the other two positions of the said diagram; and



- 4. directs that the authorised light signal may only be placed at the said site if the apparatus (including the content of all instructions stored in it) used in connection with it is of a type which has been approved by the Secretary of State as appropriate to the site and application; and
- 5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised markings A and B and the authorised light signal, at or near the said sites, shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised markings A and B, or the authorised light signal, and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulation 12 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised marking A in the same manner as they apply to the road marking shown in diagram 1003.3 in Schedule 6 to those Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 31 and 43 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised marking B in the same manner as they apply to the road marking shown in diagram 1001.2 in Schedule 6 to those Regulations.








