



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTIONS 64 AND 65  
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of two-stage right turns for cyclists, hereby:-

1. authorises the placing at appropriate sites on the Transport for London Route Network and on Cycle Superhighways of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign A”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown as Sign A in the attached set of drawings numbered GT50/139/0142-1; and
2. authorises the placing at the said sites of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as “the authorised sign B”) conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown as Sign B in the said set of drawings; and
3. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised signs A and B may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order; and
4. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised signs A and B at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month’s notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised signs A and B and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.



The provisions of Regulation 12 and 31 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113, "the 2002 Regulations") shall apply to the authorised sign A in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 954.5 in Schedule 5 to the 2002 Regulations.

The provisions of Regulations 12 and 31 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign B in the same manner as they apply to the sign to diagram 2601.2 in Schedule 7 to those Regulations.

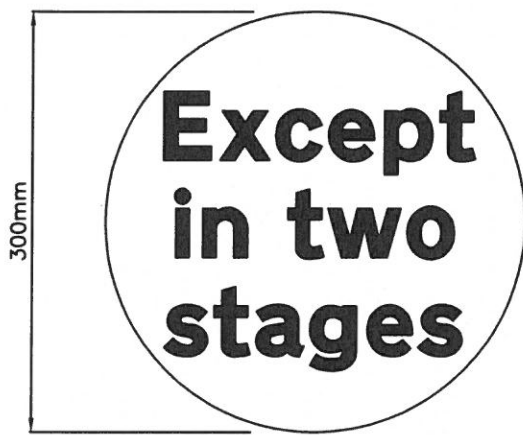
